About the Role

The Multimedia Designer and Technologist, is responsible for providing technical expertise to assist professional working groups with developing new and revising current e-learning courses. This position supports projects internally and is responsible for tasks and assignments associated with the development of training services and programs.

Main Responsibilities

E-Learning Design

- Create, maintain, revise, and evaluate e-learning content using various software programs.
- Work with project team to plan, design and develop SCORM compliant e-learning modules.
- Develop storyboards and scripts for e-learning and virtual live training.
- Upload, configure and export e-learning content into the Learning Management System (LMS).
- Integrate emerging instructional methods and technologies into e-learning.
- Build out framework and quality assurance using test drives.

Multimedia Development

- Create multimedia products using a variety of software programs.
- Deliver products on-time with minimal defects.
- Manipulate and edit digital imagery, video and incorporates graphics and effects.
- Manipulate and edit videos, sound effects and audio using various multimedia software.
- Maintain, update and upload content for organizational websites.

Graphic Design

- Create images and animations that identify a concept or convey a message using software programs.
- Develop graphics for classroom-based training, online training, and websites.
- Select colors, images, text style and layouts that are professional and convey a specific message.
- Implement edits recommended by internal and external clients.
- Review designs for errors before printing or publishing.
- Develop graphics for course catalogs and course information sheets.
- Develop graphics for various organizational programs.

Instructional Design

- Develop instructor manuals, user guides, and Microsoft PowerPoint presentations.
- Apply creative designs to the discipline of instructional design with an emphasis on multimedia.
- Develop instructional programs that leverage new technologies and multimedia.
- Apply interactive design and interactive learning principles to instructional solutions geared towards adult learners.
- Select, modify, and integrate existing instructional materials to employ multimedia and emerging technologies.
- Produce virtual-live training programs using various software programs.

Other Duties as Assigned

- Provide technical assistance with LMS and Customer Relationship Management System (CRM).
- Train staff on LMS, CRM and other productivity software as required.
- Perform other related tasks as assigned by the Senior Manager, Centralized Services.

Job Requirements

Education

- Post-Secondary degree or diploma in Curriculum Development, Educational Technology or Multimedia Design or other relevant field of study.

Relevant Experience

- Minimum 3 years of demonstrated experience as an e-learning design.
- Minimum 3 years of progressive work experience in training and development or related function.
- Minimum of 2 years' experience working with e-learning authoring software (e.g. Articulate Storyline/360, Adobe Captivate).
- Minimum of 2 years' experience working with LMS platforms (e.g. Adobe Captivate Prime).
- Minimum of 2 years' experience working with Multimedia Software (e.g. Adobe Creative Cloud).
- Experienced with adult learning principles and practices and their applications to program development and instructional design.
- Demonstrated experience in leading program development, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of training programs, including train-the-trainer models.
- Experience working within employment or training services is an asset.
- Experience in public speaking, delivering presentations, and/or facilitating workshops.
- Demonstrated experience coordinating multiple projects and managing shifting priorities.
- Experience working within a not-for-profit or non-profit environment.

- Advanced use of relevant software and platforms (Adobe Captivate Prime, Shift IQ, etc.).
- Advance use of MS Office Suite including: Word, Excel, and PowerPoint.
- Intermediate skills using Adobe Creative Suite including Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign, Premier Pro, Acrobat DC, Audition, After Effects and Apple iMovie.
- Intermediate skills using communication software such as MS Teams, Zoom, GoToWebinar, etc.
- Intermediate use of WordPress and HTML.

- Ability to work at a detailed level while maintaining an overall project perspective.
